Swimming

Children in Key Stage 2 (Year 3-6) will be swimming on Tuesday afternoons from Tuesday 11th September until Tuesday 9th October inclusive.

Children in Foundation and Key Stage 1 (R-Year 2) will be swimming on Tuesday afternoons from Tuesday 16th October until Tuesday 20th November inclusive. (Not including 23rd October which is half term).

Please ensure your children have appropriate swimming kit.

Each child will be in a small group taught by a qualified instructor for 45 minutes.

Consider what your children are wearing that day also – it can be really hard to put tights on after swimming!

Children will be transported by bus to Ruby Oak Park and return within the school day.
