Science	<p>What is a Shadow?</p> <p>For a shadow to be formed an object must block light.</p>

	<p>Transparent / Translucent / Opaque?</p> <p>Find examples of these around the house and use a light source to see what sort of shadow they do or do not create .</p>
Music	<p>THIS WEEK FIND TYPICAL MUSIC FROM AUSTRALIA !! (Aboriginal)</p> <p>LISTEN AND RESPOND, WHICH INSTRUMENTS CAN YOU HEAR? HOW DO YOU FEEL. DRAW THE INSTRUMENTS, YOU COULD EVEN PAINT WHILST LISTENING TO THE MUSIC!</p>
MFL - French	<p>This activity helps you with the pronunciation of the days of the week. You could play a matching game by linking each day with what it is named after. Then you can stick the pieces onto the sheet and also have a go at the wordsearch if you have time.</p>
RE	<p>People who believe, and like to pray to God, often like to pray through his son Jesus too. Singing is a form of praying. Usually, at this time of year our Year 6 start to think about their favourite hymns. As we haven't been able to join together recently to sing, maybe you would like to think about your favourite hymns? Go online and look up our school hymn book, "Come and Praise". Find the lyrics to a hymn you enjoy and write them out neatly to practise your joined up handwriting. Write a couple of sentences to explain the message of the hymn.</p>
