Week 3 English	Task	Activity	Teaching/Learning Points
Monday	The Great British Spag Off – Who killed the Chef? Task 1	Read the attached Story Keep the suspect checklist at hand Tackle Task 1—Base on knowledge of Capital Letters	You can read the story with an adult. When you have highlighted the capital letters you should then be able to discount some of the suspects
Tuesday	Task 2	Tackle Task 2—Based on your knowledge of prefixes and tenses complete each sentence with the correct prefix and recognizing the correct tense you should have a sentence.	When you have completed the sentences and used the table at the bottom of the sheet you should be able to eliminate some suspects.
Wednesday	Task 3	Tackle Task 3—Based on your knowledge of determiners you should be able to highlight letters that make up a sentence.	Determiners are words that determine how many of a thing/person/object there are. The final highlighted sentence should eliminate some suspects
Thursday	Task 4	Tackle Task 4—Based on your knowledge of prepositions, you should be able to highlight letters that make up a sentence	A preposition is a word that tells you where or when something is in relation to something else. The final sentence should eliminate some suspects.

Friday	Task 5	Tackle Task 5 - based on your knowledge of types of words, use the table to make up a sentence.	Looking at types of words ie nouns, adjectives etc. When finished you should be able to find the killer. **Answer sheet will be provided**
