

# Exbourne C of E (KS2 Year 3 4) – Termly overview Spring 2022 – Class 2

**HISTORY:** We will be studying the Anglo-Saxon and Scots, examining how different groups invaded Britain after the Romans left before looking at their beliefs and how they have had an influence on our own lives today.



**ENGLISH:** As with the Autumn Term, this Spring we will study a range of genres including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. We will start with a picture book called 'Myth Atlas' looking at myths from around the world. We will then use texts 'King of Birds' and 'The Book of Bones' to assist in developing the children's reading and writing skills.




We will continue to work on embedding our statutory spelling knowledge and handwriting to enhance our writing skills. **Children are also expected to read as much as possible at home; we expect children to read at least 5 x per week. This is one of the most important things you can do at home to help.**

## RE/ PSHE:

RE this term will study festivals important to Muslims and how their forms of worship show what matters to them.

In PHSE, we will be learning about valuing difference and being the best we can be! Our learning is linked to our core Christian value PERSEVERENCE.




## Science:

## Art:


Art will explore the simple shapes that make up all pictures and drawing, learning how to use these shapes to create their own work.

## Music:

**MATHS:** Maths this term will continue to focus on the basics of maths to ensure that all pupils have a thorough understanding to build the rest of their knowledge. This will begin with number work on multiplication and division. Reasoning, fluency and problem solving will still underpin all maths lessons to prepare the children for their future learning.
