

## Exbourne class (KS2) - Termly overview Summer Term 2022 - Mr Waites

### History and Geography

In the first half-term we will be examining the Industrial Revolution and Victorian Britain, looking at social, economic and cultural change that was part and parcel of this era.

The second half-term will then look at Population, how it changes depending on the culture and society behind it and how this in turn impacts the wider world around us.

**English:** This Summer term will see the Year 5's working with a film study to examine different forms of writing and how to adapt language to suit.

Year 6 will be focusing on their SATS practice, with practice papers, support, and development in the skill of answering questions effectively.

We will continue to work on our statutory spelling knowledge and handwriting to enhance our writing function and capabilities.

**French** - We will continue to work with our specialist, Mrs Jordan, and aim to develop our language and written skills including letter writing!

**PSHE:** Our PSHE lessons in Spring will focus on the wider world, decision making and choices we make. We will also learn about Growing and Changing. Our spirituality, well-being and mental health will focus prominently throughout this year as well as physical health, activity and diet.



### Science:

In this Summer term science unit, we will be looking at physical and chemical changes on states of matter.

This is building on last terms work with matter and through research and experimentation we will get to study different materials and substances and how they change from gas to liquid, liquid to solid and solid to liquids. And how we can use this knowledge in a wider world context.

## Class 3 – Summer 2022

**RE** – In RE this term we will be looking at the Jewish Faith and why the Torah is so important to them. This is an inclusive lesson where we are developing our understanding of the world around us and the peoples that live in it and what faith means to all.

**Drama / Music** – We will continue to benefit from the support of our Drama specialist working towards a Jubilee performance as well as the use of the Voices Foundation in class with our music.

Summer term is one where we look to our Year 5's to continue to grow academically, emotionally & socially while we prepare our Year 6's for life after Exbourne. This includes the need to practice and undertake our SATS and the children will be working to be the best they can at this, and I appreciate all the support you give your children in this at home and at school.

### Art / DT:

Within Art and Design we will be exploring the use of different materials and techniques in Art. We will be looking at the artist Louise Bourgeois and her work The Spider before using the second half-term looking to design and create class and individual sculptural structures of our own.

Children will follow sequential with age and ability related lessons which will give them opportunities to develop their skills with the class aim of being the best we can in the end of year assessments and SATS.

### Physical Education:

PE will play a pivotal role in the Summer term. We are pleased welcome Mr Pugh who will be leading sessions focused on health and fitness and athletics. We will continue to exercise daily, with wake up / shake up exercises throughout the day to stimulate our minds and keep us refreshed and energised.
