

Personal, Social, Emotional Development:

Throughout the autumn term, we will be thinking about ourselves and what makes us special. This will include learning about who is special to us and our different feelings. We will also be focusing on the Exbourne golden rules throughout the term. We will observe and record the children's progress in their Learning Journal.

Communication and Language:

This term we will be using language to imagine and re-create roles and experiences in play. This will include our own experiences activities that we do in different seasons. Following on from exploring books on a daily basis we will also be encouraging children to use stories and narratives in their play. Through the use of peer and whole class work the children will continue to develop their language.

Expressive Art and Design:

In art and design, we will be observing others and experimenting with a variety of mediums, materials and colour to create different marks. In music, we will be learning about rhythm and learning to play my own improvisation within a song.



Literacy:

To develop our reading and writing skills we will begin learning our letters and sounds through daily phonics sessions. The children will have opportunities to explore books within the classroom. Writing opportunities will be available within the children's play.



Mathematics:

In Maths we will be building numbers up to 10 using a variety of representations. We will count to 10 and look at the different patterns. We will use numicon and other concrete resources to represent different numbers and know what is one more and one less.



Physical Development:

In PE, we will be mastering basic movements and how we travel around including running, jumping, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination. We will also be strengthening our fingers and arms ready for writing, through fine motor activities.



Understanding the World:

We will be learning about the weather and seasons. We will be talking about how the seasons change and what we might find in each season and describing the different weather patterns. We also look at different features in our school environment and what our school was like in the past.
