Personal, Social, Emotional Development:

As children settle into school, the will learn about the golden rules and the behaviour expectation at school. We will talk about different feelings and learn how to recognise these feelings. We will use role play activities to help children recognise what they should do if they feel cross or angry. We will talk about our friends and how we can care for them.

Communication and Language:

We will have lots of discussions, talking about our home experiences. Children will learn to follow instructions and develop new vocabulary. We will talk about people that are special to us and which adults can help us. Through reading stories, we will notices the similarities and use common refrains such as once upon a time to tell our own stories.

Expressive Art and Design:

In art and design, we will be observing others and experimenting with a variety of mediums, materials and colour to create different marks.

In music, we will be learning about rhythm and learning to play my own improvisation within a song.



Literacy:

Will be starting our early reading journey and learning the individual letter sounds through our Read Write Inc program. Children will have daily sessions and begin to learn to recognise, read and write the sounds as well as learning to segment and blend. They will be able to say the initial sounds in words. We will write simple cvc words and be able to recognise and write our name. We will share lots of stories and discuss the different characters and join in with repeated refrains. We will learn to locate the title of a book.


Understanding the World:

We will learn about the four seasons and discover the signs of Autumn. We will think about the festival of harvest and what that means and why it is held. We will explore the environment using our senses and learn what we need to ensure that we are healthy. Later in the term we will think about Christmas and how different families have different traditions.

Mathematics:

In Maths we will be building numbers up to 10 using a variety of representations. We will count to 10 and look at the different patterns. We will use numicon and other concrete resources to represent different numbers and know what is one more and one less. We will also learn different songs involving numbers.



Physical Development:

In PE, we will be mastering basic ball skills involving throwing, catching and kicking as well as going swimming. We will also be strengthening our fingers and arms ready for writing, through fine motor activities including threading, playing with playdough and more.
