

Personal, Social, Emotional Development:

We will be thinking about how we can stay safe; this will include thinking about what is safe to eat, keep ourselves safe both indoors and outdoors, online and how other people help to keep us safe. We also be learning about how we can look after special people, including our friends and family, how we can be help both at home and in the classroom and how we can care for the world around us.

Literacy:

We will develop our reading and writing further using the Read Write Inc phonics programme. We will be able to locate the title in books and read with one to one correspondence. We will be able to segment and blend simple words and read with increasing confidence. We will begin to write different lists, labels and captions linking to the texts that we are reading.



Understanding the World:

We will be exploring London, thinking about our own experiences of cities, and looking at the different types of transport in London and how that differs to the transport we use. We will be recognising that people have different beliefs. We will be able to describe the special event of Easter and talk about the events that led up to Jesus rising again.



Communication and Language:

This term we will be looking at lots of different stories. We will remember key points within a story and be able to identify the characters and events within the story as well as answer questions about the text. We also be able to discuss different stories as a group and ask how and why questions. We will also learn different songs, poems and rhymes and perform them.

Expressive Art and Design:

This term, we will be exploring how colour can be changed and start using junk modelling to build houses, bridges and transport. Children will begin to build a collection of songs following the Voice Foundation scheme, which involves short sessions of singing daily. Also, children will be engaging with a Drama workshop weekly, provided by Mrs Davis and these skills will be developed through literacy too.

Mathematics:

In Maths we will be understanding what 0 means and comparing numbers to 5. We will be looking at combining groups to make up to 10 using this to find out number bonds to 10. We will also be exploring length and height and weight and capacity as well as 3D shapes.
