

GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY:

We will be exploring the city of London, thinking about what London is and how London was created. We will also be investigating historic events that could have destroyed the city of London including The Great Fire on London and the Blitz. We will also look at the different land marks that there are in London and the different types of transport used.

ENGLISH:

In English we will be continuing our phonics learning and application to spelling through the Read Write Inc programme. We will look at a variety fiction, non fiction and poetry texts. We will think about how we can plan and develop our story writing through different sections and using more adventurous vocabulary. We will think about the different type of sentences we can use for different purposes such as commands, exclamations, questions and statements. Through our handwriting sessions we will practise our letter formation, thinking about the size of our writing.

PSHE:

We will be thinking about keeping ourselves safe through having a healthy lifestyle as well as how to stay safe online. We will learn what to do and who we can go to if we feel unsafe.

RE:

This term we will be completing a double unit exploring the question 'Who are Muslims and how do they live?' During these sessions, children will look at Muslim beliefs and how these are shown in their day-to-day practices.

SCIENCE:

We will be learning about sound, how we hear and what we can do to look after our ears. We will be able to describe the different pitches of sounds and also how we can make different sounds. In the second of term we will be looking at materials and how we can use them for different purposes.

ART AND DESIGN/ DT/ MUSIC:

We will be exploring colour by replicating the Great Wave image by Hokusai using paint and pastels. This will allow children to explore making different shades of a colour and develop skills such as blending with pastels. In Music, we will be using the Voices Foundation Scheme to embed singing into the daily routine. This term we will focus on listening, imitating, performing and finding our singing voices to collectively sing at the same pitch.

MATHS:

This term, Year 2 children will begin to look at multiplication and division and hoe we can apply these facts to problem solving. Year 1 children will learn addition and subtraction facts up to 20 using different resources to help them find these. We will be looking at money, learning the value of each coin, how we can use a variety of different coins to make different amounts and



learning about change.

PHYSICAL/OUTDOOR EDUCATION:

We will be doing dance and movement this term with Ellodie Stott. We will be learning how to copy different movements as well as improvising our own. We will string movements together to create our own dance. Children will have weekly lessons with a visitor from the Devon Wildlife Trust.
