Personal, Social, Emotional Development:

We will be thinking about the importance of exercise and how we need to be resilient when things gets tough. Look at the world around us, we will be learning how to be kind to living creatures and taking care of animals. We will continue to build our confidence as we undertake new experiences and learn how to understand the feelings of others.

Communication and Language:

This term we will be practising talking about what we have been doing, practising describing them in detail - sharing our weekend news and what we have been up to at home. This will also included talking about experiences that they have had a points during the school year. We will be learning to recite and sing different song and poems. We will talk about similarities and differences between things in the past and now.

Expressive Art and Design:


This term, we will be observing caterpillars, taking photos and painting butterflies. They will also have the opportunity to try various fruits and vegetables and make their own recipe. Children will continue to build a collection of songs following the Voice Foundation scheme. Also, children will be engaging with a Drama workshop weekly and these skills will be developed through literacy too.

Literacy:

We will continue to develop our reading and writing further using the Read Write Inc phonics programme. We will begin to notice when we have made errors in our reading and writing, we will write sentences using a range of tricky words that are spelt correctly and begin to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

Understanding the World:

We will be look at the life cycles of different animals, and how we can show care to the and concern for living things in the environment and how we can look after our world. We will discuss what we have noticed about plants. animals, natural and found objects.

In RE, we will be looking at the questions 'Which places are special and why?' and 'Which stories are special and why?'

Mathematics:

In Maths we will be building numbers beyond 10 using a range of resources, doubling numbers and practising sharing and grouping. We will think about odd and even numbers and adding and taking away numbers. Finally, we will be looking at different patterns and relationships.
