

GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY:

We will be travelling back to Ancient Egypt and looking at how important the River Nile was to the Ancient Egyptians, how we can use archaeology to help us find out about the past, have a go at reading some hieroglyphics and understand the importance of pharaohs as leaders. After half term we will be comparing and contrasting the UK with Australia.

ENGLISH:

In English we will be continuing our phonics learning and application to spelling through the Read Write Inc programme. We will listen to and read a variety of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts. We will discuss and answer questions about them. During the writing sessions we will be learning to punctuate sentences correctly and write in a variety of styles and be able to identify and use nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs. Through our handwriting sessions we will practise our letter formation, thinking about the size of our writing and some children will begin to join their letters.

PSHE:

We will be thinking how we can be our very best by eating healthily, staying well and understanding that to be our best we need to put effort in to those things we find tricky. We will then look at how we have grown and changed since we were a baby.

RE:

This term, we will be exploring the questions 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?' and 'What is the 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings?'

SCIENCE:

In Science, we will be exploring the world of plants. Having a go at growing our own and understanding what plants need to grow. We will also look at the different parts of plants and trees. After half term we will move onto learning about animals, looking at the difference between vertebrates and invertebrates, mammals and birds and what food animals need to stay alive.

ART AND DESIGN/ DT/ MUSIC:

This term, we will be finishing our Vincent Van Gogh unit about sunflowers before moving onto our DT topic 'Eat More Fruits and Vegetables' where the children will taste various fruits and vegetables before making their own recipe.

In music, we will be continuing to sing daily following the Voices Foundation scheme.

MATHS:

This term, Year 2 children will be revisiting their learning from this year as well looking at different forms of measures including money, time, capacity, temperature, and mass. We will also learn about position and direction. Year 1 children will learn basic facts about multiplication and division and fraction. They will continue with the place value of numbers up to 100 and also



learn about time, position and direction.

PHYSICAL/OUTDOOR EDUCATION:

This term, we will be practicing our athletic skills, doing lots of running, throwing and jumping as well as getting ready for sports day.

Children will have weekly lessons with a visitor from the Devon Wildlife Trust which will also link to our science learning.



Computing:
